

Past the Kokuba River is an expansive park, Onoyama Park, a charming area where visitors can get close to the greenery and water. Many large-scale events are conducted in Onoyama Park. Get there from Onoyama-koen Station or approach it from Tsubogawa Station on the 10-meter wide pedestrian bridge, Kita Meijibashi Bridge. Asahibashi Station is connected to Naha Bus Terminal and can be used for traffic as well.

Onoyama Athletic Park E-5

The park is also the location for the Onoyama Citizen's Festival and various other events. In addition to being known as the main site of the Naha Marathon, Onoyama Park is famous fo being a comprehensive sports complex where many large-scale events are conducted. Including track and field, various sports schools are operated in the many facilities. Kita Meijibashi Bridge has become a pedestrian walk and is directly connected to Tsubogawa Station, allowing smooth access to the complex
